

IMPORTANT LEGAL RULINGS ABOUT PARTNERSHIPS:

- Two kinds of partnerships in livestock:
 - 1. Based on percentage, not individual animals
 - 2. Based on individual animals (branded, identifiable)
- Both are counted as one singular entity, so long as:
 - 1. Both are Muslims
 - 2. Animals share the same farm, pasture, studs, milking area
- Animals are not to be joined or separated to avoid zakaah...





As Always Deception is Forbidden in Islaam:

((لَا يُجْمَعُ بَيْنَ مُتَفَرِّقٍ، وَلَا يُفَرَّقُ بَيْنَ مُجْتَمِع خَشْيَةَ الصَّدَقَةِ))

It was collected by Imaam Aboo Daawood (#1580) and others, Shaykh Al-Albaanee graded it: hasan.





ZAKAAH ON THINGS EXTRACTED FROM THE GROUND

يَتَأَيُّهَا ٱلَّذِينَءَامَنُوٓ أَنْفِقُواْ مِن طَيِّبَتِ مَا كَسَبْتُمْ وَمِمَّا أَخْرَجْنَالَكُمْ مِنَ ٱلْأَرْضِ وَلَا تَيَمَّمُواْ ٱلْخَبِيثَ مِنْهُ تُنفِقُونَ وَلَسْتُم بِعَا خِذِيهِ إِلَّا أَن تُغْمِضُواْ فِيهِ وَٱعْلَمُوۤاْ أَنَّ ٱللَّهَ غَنِیُّ حَكِمِیدُ ﴿ ﴾





ZAKAAH DUE ON CROPS:

- Zakaatable crops: storable dry foods, sold by volume Includes: rice, grain, dates, raisins (not grapes), wheat, barley, etc.
 Not included: fruits, vegetables, watermelon, onion, garlic
- The nisaab is 5 wisqs (300 saa', or 900 litres)
 ((نیس فیما دون خمسة أوسنُق صدقة)) ق / عن أبي سعید
- Amount due = 5% when irrigated manually, otherwise 10%.
 ۱٤٨٣ عمر في خ ١٤٨٣



Precious Metals & Natural Resources:

- Zinc, copper, coal, oil, gold, silver, diamonds, gems, etc.
- NOT: pearls, corral, amber, musk, etc.
- Nisaab: the nisaab of gold (85 grams) or silver (595 grams)*
 (*Session 4 includes details on this topic, in shaa' Allaah.)
- Amount due: 2.5% of the value after cleaning





ZAKAAT DUE ON HONEY:

- Nisaab: 30 Saa's (90 litres)*
- Amount due: 10%*
- *As mentioned by Shaykh Saalih al-Fowzaan.
- The scholars differ, without decisive evidence either way.

 'Umar @ Salabah Valley: If they give you the tenth they used to give...

 protect their valley for them.



ZAKAAH ON BURIED TREASURE:

- Rikaaz: Wealth buried from non-Muslim currencies or wealth
- NOT: Muslim currencies, or unidentifiable sources (lost & found)
- The nisaab: none (unique)
- The amount due: 20%
